Apply online.

1. Go to www.americanmedtech.org and under "Certification" choose "Check Eligibility."
2. Select the certification of your choice and review the eligibility requirements to make sure you meet the criteria to apply.
3. If you meet the requirements, go to "Apply" and complete the application.
