- Apply online via the education route and submit education documentation
- Connect your application to your school, if applicable

- Get The AMT Edge, a free tool, that will help you prepare through interactive activities and tips, and peer networking



3. Sit for Exam

- Schedule online to select your exam date and location; at your school, or at one of Pearson VUE's testing sites located nationwide
- Results are sent to AMT within 48 hours; retakes are permitted after 45 days

- Earning your certification means you are now an AMT member
- Display your credentials and a digital badge alongside your name in all professional communications
