

THE ARTHUR SCHANTZ, M.D. MEMORIAL TECHNOLOGY AWARD

Arthur Schantz, M.D. studied medicine at the Harvard Medical School after completing his undergraduate degree at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology in Cambridge, MA. Dr. Schantz completed his residency and fellowship in Anatomic and Clinical Pathology at Massachusetts General Hospital. During his 40+ years as a pathologist, Dr. Schantz had been affiliated with respected institutions such as Virtua Health System and Quest Diagnostics in Horsham, PA.

At the time of his passing, Dr. Schantz was serving as Chief Pathologist and Laboratory Director for Cooper University Hospital in Camden, NJ and as Laboratory Director for Regional Women's Lab in Marlton, NJ. Dr. Schantz was ahead of his time adapting to electronic medical records before his peers. Giving credit to his Alma Mater, MIT, Dr. Schantz was a leader and innovator.

The Arthur Schantz, M.D. Memorial Technology Award celebrates technology in medicine.

The Arthur Schantz Memorial Technology Award is presented by the State Society of AMT. The award of \$500 and a commemorative plaque will be presented at the AMT National Meeting. Transportation, room, board and admission to the award dinner for the recipient will be paid by the NJSSAMT.

A. The criteria for this award are:

- i. Be a current certified or registered member of AMT.
 - i. Have contributed to the use of Electronic Health Records (EHR) or Laboratory Information Systems (LIS)
 - a) by authoring an article that has been published or accepted for publication,
 - b) by developing an educational program, or
 - c) by spearheading the advanced use of such by their peers.
- ii. Be currently working in the field.

B. Nomination Procedure:

- i. Nominations may be made by:
 - a) Members of NJSSAMT Board of Directors
 - b) AMT District Councilor
 - c) Active members of NJSSAMT
- ii. Each nominator is entitled to one nominee only each year.
- iii. The nominations must be completed and received on or before January 31. Nominations received after this date will not be considered.
- iv. After the January deadline, the NJSSAMT Office will distribute copies of the nominations and rating form to the appropriate members for their evaluation and comments.

C. Selection of Recipients:

The NJSSAMT Board of Directors, from all nominations meeting the stated criteria, will select the recipient of this award at their spring meeting.

- i. This award may be received only one time.
- ii. Unsigned forms will be considered invalid
- iii. Any nominations found not to meet the criteria for this award will not be considered and will be returned to the nominating entity.
